- Flores was an excellent TA, her lectures were engaging, well-organized, and helped me further understand the material. She always reviewed class concepts we were covering this week, along with relevant problems that were similar to the ones in the homework so I benefited a lot from attending her discussion section. Especially after midterms week, I found it extremely useful that she went over test questions that most students got wrong so I could spot my mistakes and learn the correct steps the second time around. And she was always open to answering questions and reclarifying the material. My only criticism is that sometimes her lecturing style was far too fast paced so it was a challenge to take notes and process the main points before they were erased from the board.
- My TA Diana was the best economics TA I have ever had. She is so knowledgeable, clear, and approachable. She would even go out of her way to think of examples in our lives where the material we were learning could be applied. In the office hours she would stay late sometimes to help us out and had any other questions. I told some of my friends in the class about Diana and they started attending Diana's discussion because they learned so clearly from her. I cannot compliment Diana enough.
